Hardeeville Fire Department Lowers its ISO Rating

Hardeeville, SC – (November 29, 2022) -The City of Hardeeville is proud to announce that it's fire department was recently awarded with a significant rating improvement. The Insurance services Organization changed the rating of the fire department from a three (3) rating to a two (2) rating. Effective on March 1, 2023. This is a major accomplishment. Only 4.4% of the fire departments in the nation are rated at a two (2).

The ISO rating is used to determine property and casualty insurance rates. This means that Hardeeville residents could soon see a reduction on their homeowner's insurance for fire protection.

There are several factors used in determining the rating of a fire department. Some of the top factors include:

- > **Needed Fire Flows, which are representative building locations used to determine the theoretical amount of water necessary for fire suppression purposes.**
- > **Emergency Communications, including emergency reporting, telecommunicators, and dispatching systems.**
- > **Fire Department, including equipment, staffing, training, geographic distribution of fire companies, operational considerations, and community risk reduction.**
- > **Water Supply, including inspection and flow testing of hydrants, alternative water supply operations, and a careful evaluation of the amount of available water compared with the amount needed to suppress fires up to 3,500 gpm.**
